This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 10 dated 17.2.2014 under section 306 I.P.C registered at Police Station Mukandpur, District S.B.S. Nagar.

It has gone uncontroverted that the present petitioner, who is the mother-in-law of deceased Harpreet Kaur, had been found innocent during the course of investigation but thereafter had been summoned as additional accused by way of an application having been filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

On 13.1.2015, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Contends that the petitioner is mother-in-law of deceased Harpreet Kaur. There is no allegation of abetment or instigation and no incriminating evidence was collected against her during investigation. Petitioner has been summoned under section 319 Cr.P.C to face the trial.

Notice of motion for 12.3.2015.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice and seeks time.

Copy of paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel in Court.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the trial court, who shall admit her on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.”

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that in pursuance to the order dated 13.1.2015, the petitioner had duly appeared before the Trial Court on 19.1.2015 and had been admitted to bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of in terms of making the order dated 13.1.2015 as absolute.
