The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No.4 to 6.

The petitioners moved representation (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2, for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances of petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-6) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
