JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 121, dated 28.10.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 14.03.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected between the parties and the same is genuine and without any pressure from any corner. Even otherwise, matter involved is

personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 121, dated 28.10.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
