Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.113 dated 03.04.2013, registered at Police Station Sonapat City, District Sonapat, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Sukhbir Singh submits that out of 22 prosecution witnesses, 2 witnesses are yet to be examined and trial is at the fag end.

Being faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

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Dismissed being not pressed.

However, petitioner will be at liberty to file petition for bail, if prosecution evidence is not concluded within one month.
