Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 59, dated 08.04.2013, under Sections 498-A and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that complainant has entered into a compromise with accused party and complainant has no objection if compromise is accepted and FIR is quashed. Even

otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 59, dated 08.04.2013, under Sections 498-A and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.
