Trial Court record has been received.

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Devender Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Detective), Hisar has been filed by the learned State counsel accompanied with a letter received from the Director, Forensic Science Laboratory, Haryana Madhuban, which shows that only four number of teeth samples were received in the laboratory for DNA comparison with the petitioner and the same were consumed up during examination and no sample was left for further examination.

In view of this status report, as no sample of the body organ of the deceased for further DNA test is available with the prosecution thus faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner pleads that the present petition may be dismissed being not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.

The Registry is directed to return the trial Court record immediately. It should be ensured that the record of the trial Court should reach within a week by deputing a special messenger.
