The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. raising an apprehension with regard to threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5. Accordingly, prayer has been raised for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take adequate measures for protection of life and liberty.

Without even going into the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition at the initial stage itself in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, respondent No.3 as regards his grievance and apprehension and who in turn would be obligated to examine the matter and thereafter to take steps as he may deem fit and as would be warranted strictly in accordance with law.
