Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.230 dated 7.10.2014 under Sections 420/419/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

This Court vide order dated 8.4.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer and compliance of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 8.4.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required in the present case.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 8.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
