respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Gurdaspur, to look into the allegations contained in representation dated 31.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if warranted, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

It is made clear that if a complaint for criminal offence or an FIR is pending, this order shall not cause any hindrance in those proceedings.
