MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner is fugitive of law since 27.1.2014 leading to initiation of proceedings against him under Section 82 Cr.P.C.. There would thus be no justifiable reason to exercise the power under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in his favour.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he is willing to submit himself to the process of law. Noticing this contention, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner would submit himself to the process of law by surrendering before the court of competent jurisdiction within a period of two weeks from today, upon which his prayer for regular bail would be considered by the said court in accordance with law, on such a prayer being made by the petitioner. The

needful shall be done as expeditiously as possible but not later than four days from the date of making such a prayer.

Petition disposed of.
