This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of impugned order dated 15.03.2014, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereby, the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the cross examination of the prosecutrix, some material documents including photographs of the petitioner were not put by the counsel, which were necessary for the just decision of the case.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that all the prosecution witnesses including the Dws have been examined. The trial is at the fag end.

In this case, the statement of the prosecutrix was recorded on 19.10.2013. She was subjected to lengthy cross examination; full opportunity was granted to the defence counsel to cross examine her. When the case came up for final arguments, the petitioner moved application on 05.03.2014 with an intention to prolong the case. The learned trial Court has rightly dismissed the application of the petitioner under Section 311 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Keeping in view the above, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
