Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 read with Section 167(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail to Chhinder Singh and Joginder Singh (petitioners) in case FIR No. 57 dated 03.06.2014, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'Act') registered at Police Station City-II, Abohar, District Fazilka.

2. A copy of report of Chemical Examiner, Punjab has been furnished by learned State counsel, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

3. A perusal of report transpires that Tramadol Hydrochloride was found in the contents of alleged contraband. Learned State counsel has

fairly conceded that the ingredients found during analysis of sample being Tramadol Hydrochloride, the case does not fall in the list of articles so as to attract the provisions of Act. It can be safely concluded that Section 22 of Act is not attracted the facts and circumstances of the case in hand.

4. Accordingly, instant petition is allowed and petitioners are ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
