The allegations of the prosecution in this regular bail application preferred by Rajesh-petitioner are that on 24.1.2015, he was found to be in conscious possession of 230 grams of charas. The submissions of petitioner's counsel are that the petitioner is in custody since 24.1.2015 and that the recovered quantity of contraband is non-commercial one and that he is first offender which facts have not been refuted on behalf of the State.

Without going into the merits of the case, in the light of the fact that completion of investigations shall take time and so the trial, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is not warranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
