This petition has been moved by Sombir under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.426 dated 23.12.2014 registered under Section 20 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at at Police Station Sadar, Gohana (Sonapat).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that report of the Chemical Examiner regarding the substance recovered from the petitioner is yet to come and charge-sheet was filed in Court without that. This fact is affirmed by the other side.

State Counsel, however, submits that commercial quantity of charas was recovered from the petitioner. Therefore, bail should be declined.

At this stage, it is felt that there is no ground for granting bail to the petitioner. However, the petitioner may move the Court again after the report of the Chemical Examiner is received and if there is any change in the circumstances.

Dismissed.
