Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.75 dated 2.3.2015 under Sections 15/27-A/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Bhuna.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 6.4.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jai Chand, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and submits that his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage. He further submits that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail by the trial Court.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 6.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
