This petition has been filed by petitioner Surmu under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter called Cr.P.C) for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 4 dated 22.01.2015, under Sections 457, 380 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter called IPC), registered at Police Station Tibbar, District Gurdaspur

As per the prosecution allegations two buffaloes belonging to complainant Jodh Singh were stolen. The name of the present petitioner was revealed in the disclosure statement of co-accused Liakat.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Vipin Kumar states that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and has been sufficiently interrogated. His custodial interrogation is not required. The recovery of buffaloes has already been effected from the possession of co-accused Liakat. So, there is no justification for the detention of the present petitioner.

Thus, the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 06.04.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petition stands disposed of.
