Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Crl. Complaint No. 142/1/09 titled as "Paramjit Kaur vs. Gurmel Singh and others, under Sections 406/498-A IPC, pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner shall surrender/appear before the Court and shall seek regular bail and her bail application should be decided expeditiously.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner may surrender/appear before the Court. In the event of her doing

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so, her regular bail application be decided expeditiously in accordance with law, keeping in view the age of the petitioner.
