Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising from FIR No.219 dated 25.10.2013 under Sections 364-A/365/342/506 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted bail and the petitioners are entitled to bail on the ground of parity. The petitioners have been behind bars since 26.03.2014 and 02.04.2014, respectively. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioners are not required for custodial

interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the fact that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted regular bail and also the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner are ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
