Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No. 31 dated 6.2.2015 registered under Sections 4 and 5 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Notice to Advocate General, Haryana.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Manoj Kumar Sangwan, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of false implication. She also places reliance on the statement, Annexure P-2 (colly) at page 12 of the paper-book, to contend that the story put forth by the prosecution has been found doubtful. She prays for allowing the present petition.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhminder Singh, Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, submits that petitioner is the main accused. There are direct and serious allegations against the petitioner. He further submits that there is another FIR bearing No.79 dated 27.3.2013 registered against the petitioner for the similar offence. He prays for dismissal of the petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition.

Permission is granted.
