This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.202 dated 18.09.2014, registered under Sections 307, 452, 326, 324, 323, 526, 201/34 IPC, at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is behind the bars since 25.10.2014 and two other co-accused namely Simrandeep Singh alias Laala and Jaspreet Singh alias Jassa have already been granted bail by the trial Court.
