The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.383 dated 06.10.2014 for offence under Sections 452/354/160/323/506/148/149 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, based on compromise.

Report from the trial Court has been received after recording statements of parties, alongwith original statements. It is reported that compromise is voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar submits that the petitioners are the only accused in this FIR and respondents No.2 and 3 are the only aggrieved person.

No useful purpose would be served in continuing with the proceedings in this case in view of the compromise arrived at between them.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgement of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 (P&H)*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012)10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.383 dated 06.10.2014 for offence under Sections 452/354/160/323/506/148/149 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar and the subsequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof, are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements.
