Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 29.7.2011 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in cross version of case FIR No.334 dated 7.11.2008, registered under Sections 323/341/148/149 IPC, at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 6.4.2015 has directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 20.4.2015 and in case the petitioner surrender before the trial Court, the trial Court was directed to admit the petitioner on bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 6.4.2015, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on interim bail.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and admitted on interim bail, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 6.4.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to face the trial in accordance with law.
