AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 80 dated 2.8.2012, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station, Mehatpur, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 30.04.2014 the parties were directed to be present before the trial Court on 13.05.2013 for recording their statements with regard to compromise. However, report from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nakodar dated 27.09.2013 has been received whereby he has reported that till date none of the parties appeared before him for getting their statements recorded.

In this view of the matter, the petition is dismissed.
