MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner is accused of having participated in a violent incident thereby attracting the provisions of Section 326 read with Section 34 IPC. It was stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that Section 326 IPC was added later on and prior to that he had been released on bail. Besides the injury under Section 326 IPC is attributed to co-accused Sukhvir Singh @ Sukhi.

Noticing the aforesaid, this court on 20.1.2015 had granted the interim protection to the petitioner subject to compliance of the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., pursuant to which he has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, which fact is not controverted by the

learned counsel for the State of Punjab on instructions from ASI
Sukhchain Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions
dated 20.1.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the
condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the
provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
