The petitioner-Daljinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 15.11.2014 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had forged an agreement to sell dated 9.08.2010 purported to have been prepared by the owner-complainant Rajesh Taneja and on the strength of the same he filed a civil suit which was dismissed on the first date of hearing for non prosecution.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the alleged document even on the face of the allegations having never been put to use and therefore applicability of offences under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC will be determined at the time of trial, has been controverted on behalf of the State.

Keeping in view allegations, culpability if any on the part of petitioner shall be determined at the time of the trial.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Presently the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within 10 days.

The present petition stands disposed off.
