Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 to 6 to conduct free, fair and impartial enquiry in case FIR no.13 dated 7.2.2014 under Sections 365, 394, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda as well as in case FIR no.15 dated 13.2.2014 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda registered against respondent no.7.

As no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 27.2.2015 as well as 18.8.2015, this Court adjourned the case for today and directed the registry to inform learned counsel for the

petitioner about the date so fixed.

As per the office report, counsel for the petitioner has been informed about the date, but still, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Reply on behalf of respondents no.1 to 6 has been filed, as per which, the CIA Staff, Bathinda had arrested one of the accused namely Kuldeep Singh on 13.2.2014 in FIR No.13 dated 7.2.2014 under Sections 365, 394, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda and an Indica car No.DL-4CM-9910 used by the accused for commission of offence, one .32 Bore country made pistol and one knife have been recovered from the personal search of Kuldeep Singh and a separate FIR No.15 dated 13.2.2014 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 has been registered against him at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Randhir Singh, submits that in the present case, police has already conducted the investigation and even charges have been framed against the accused.

In view of above, prayer of the petitioner no more survives and accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
