This order shall dispose of Criminal Misc.No.1102 of 2015
, filed by petitioner Kushal Puri and Criminal Misc.No.M-37449 of
2014, filed by petitioner Jyoti Devi, under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.125 dated 14.09.2014,
registered at Police Station Nangal, District Roopnagar, under
Sections 417, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel
appeared and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The allegation against petitioner Kushal Puri is that he has sold the mobile SIM card to petitioner Jyoti Devi and the allegation against petitioner Jyoti Devi is that she has handed over the said SIM card to convict in the jail. Both the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are no more required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 14.01.2015 (in Criminal Misc.No.M-1102 of 2015) and 22.12.2014 (in Criminal Misc.No.M-37449 of 2014, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute.
