Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 90 dated 27.05.2014, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sultanpur, District Kapurthala.

Earlier the petitioner was granted interim bail. By that time, report of chemical examiner was not received. Thereafter, chemical report has been received and his regular bail application has been dismissed by the learned Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala vide order dated 11.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with

liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move fresh regular bail application.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner may surrender/appear before the Court within a week. In the event of his doing so, his regular bail application be decided in accordance with law.
