MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner apprehends threats to her life. The facts would indicate that the petitioner was in relationship with respondent No.4 and they were intending to get married but because of the alleged relationship of respondent No.4 with another woman his marriage with the petitioner has not materialized. The petitioner now makes a grievance of this by making a representation to the SSP, Patiala. Prima facie the court would not like to interfere in such like matters where the relationship has gone wrong but this does not imply that the petitioner is without any remedy if she has some material to support such allegations against respondent No.4. For this, the appropriate remedy for the petitioner would be to approach the Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.

In so far as the threat perception to the life of the petitioner is concerned, that is always within the domain of the law enforcing agencies. Since the petitioner has already made a representation regarding such threats to the SSP, Patiala, he may look into the grievance to this limited aspect and take appropriate measures in case the situation so warrants.

Petition disposed of.
