The role attributed to the present petitioner and co-accused –
Makhan Singh is exactly the same.

Request for anticipatory bail of Makhan Singh was rejected on
06.05.2015. It was observed in that order that the matters where corporate
fraud of a larger magnitude is committed by persons who are fly by night
operators, need a deeper probe and cannot be left to simplistic explanations
of innocence.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to
the petitioner is made out.
