FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 18.06.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Mansa has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Kuldeep Singh, Harnek Singh and Bhinder Kaur as well as of complainant Ramandeep Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a matrimonial dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.11 dated 23.1.2014 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC Police Station, Kot Dharmu District Mansa and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

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Petition stands disposed off.
