The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.'), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.239 dated 01.12.2014, registered under Sections 494, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Ajnala, Distt. Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even in the FIR, the allegation is against Bhupinder Singh of solemnizing marriage with Gurpal Kaur with the help of his wife Gurdeep Kaur. Therefore, the offence, if any, is committed by Bhupinder Singh against Gurdeep Kaur, his earlier wife. Further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on

13.01.2015.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
