This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.7 dated 17.02.2015 under Sections 406/420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station P.S. Bhadson, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated. He has no role to play in the crime. Thus, concession of pre-arrest bail be granted to him.

Prayer has been opposed by learned State counsel. According to her, allegations against the petitioner are serious. His custodial interrogation is required for taking the investigating agency to a logical end.

Heard.

Complaint was made by Savinder Kumar and others. Complainants have alleged that petitioner alongwith his co-accused had taken an amount of ₹6 lacs from them and issued a receipt under signatures of Amrik Singh (petitioner herein). They assured that lease

of land of Gram Panchayat shall be granted to them. This is despite the fact that they had no competence to execute the lease deed. In this manner, they cheated the complainants and misappropriated the amount.

Keeping in view nature of allegations, I am of the considered view that petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
