This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail registered against the petitioner vide FIR No.128 dated 18.10.2010 under Sections 18/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 21st October, 2014 and contraband recovered from his is non-commercial in nature.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail. According to him, petitioner earlier absconded and was declared proclaimed offender on 29th August, 2014. He was arrested only on 21st October, 2014. According to him, possibility of petitioner absconding from process of law cannot be ruled out.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that contraband recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature and he has been incarcerated for about six months, it is directed that petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to heavy surety to be furnished by him to the satisfaction learned trial court.

The petition is allowed in these terms.
