On the last date of hearing when it was noticed that though the prosecution had availed about twenty opportunities in order to examine its evidence but none had been examined till then, the Court had directed the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to remain present in the Court in case the prosecution was not able to examine its entire evidence. Pursuant to the same, affidavit of Shri Manpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Phagwara, District Kapurthala has been filed wherein it is stated that the prosecution evidence stands closed on 8.5.2015. Even the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has been recorded and now the case fixed for arguments.

Once the trial of the case has reached its fag end, it will not be proper to consider the request of the petitioner for bail especially when the present petition is the third one filed by him.

The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
