**NAVITA SINGH, J. (Oral)**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 255 dated 07.06.2014, under Sections 382, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

It was observed on the last date of hearing that from the allegations in the FIR case under Section 382 was not made out. Even if mobile phones were stolen, it was a case of theft only.

Report from Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Nakodar has been received regarding the compromise.

It has been stated by counsel for the parties that the parties have compromised the matter. In view of this, there should not be any

impediment in allowing the parties to compromise the matter. Support to this view can be had from the authority **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab, 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 429.**

In view of the above, the petition is accepted. The above-said FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.
