Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to hand over the enquiry in FIR No.321 dated 15.11.2013 under Sections 420, 177 IPC, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar to some independent agency and to conduct enquiry in fair manner.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply on behalf of the respondents No.1, 2, 3 and 5 by way of affidavit of Balkar Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Nakodar, District Jalandhar wherein it is mentioned that after completion of the investigation, final report as provided under Section 173 Cr.PC has already been presented in the concerned Court on 8.4.2015 and even charges have been framed against

the respondent No.6 on 1.7.2015 and the case is now fixed for recording prosecution evidence for 4.11.2015. Learned counsel for the State submits that the independent enquiry has already been conducted in the present case and it is on that ground, the final report under Section 173 Cr.PC has been prepared and presented in the Court.

In view of the reply so submitted, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same.
