The present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 06.01.2012 wherein the petitioner has been declared Proclaimed Offender and for quashing the FIR No.2 dated 03.02.2011 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station NRI, Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready to submit herself to the process of law and prays for withdrawal of the instant petition confining his prayer to the limited extent that she be granted protection till the time the petitioner submits herself before the learned trial Court. Prayer is accepted.

In case, the petitioner submits herself to the process of law within a period of three months from today and she enters the country within this period for the aforesaid purpose, she shall not be arrested till the time she submits herself to the process of law by appearing before the learned trial court where after she will move an application for regular bail before the court of competent jurisdiction in accordance

with law, which shall decide her bail application as expeditiously as possible within a period of three days thereafter. Till that period, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

The present petition stands disposed of.
