Petitioner, by way of instant petition, seeks quashing of FIR No.123 dated 6.12.2010 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 148 IPC at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 31.3.2014 and parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court for getting their statements recorded, so as to enable the learned trial Court to record its satisfaction about the genuineness of the compromise.

When the parties did not appear, they were granted further opportunity vide order dated 12.9.2014. The case was adjourned to 15.12.2014. On 15.12.2014, none appeared and the case was again adjourned to 26.3.2015. Again on 5.8.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner sought and was granted time, adjourning the case for today.

Similar is the position as on date. As per the report received from the learned trial Court, parties did not appear for getting their statements recorded.

In view of the above, it seems that parties are not interested in pursuing the present petition. Having been left with no other option, this Court is of the view that petitioner as well as respondent No.2 are not entitled for any further indulgence of this Court.

Disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition on the same cause of action, as and when necessity arises.
