The petitioner was summoned as additional accused under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

He has been admitted to interim bail in terms of the last order, as is clear from the copy of order shown today passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa, on 05.05.2015, admitting the petitioner to interim bail.

Trial is likely to take a long time to complete, as evidence has practically started now because of the summoning of the petitioner as an accused along with another person.

The interim bail granted by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa, shall remain in operation during the trial, subject to any change of circumstances i.e. absence of accused or otherwise.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
