NAVITA SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 68 dated 22.02.2014, under Sections 307 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station DLF Phase-II, Gurgaon, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Report from the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon has been received after recording the statements of the parties concerned. The complainant and injured persons affirmed the compromise.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that even petitioner Rakesh Kumar was injured in the incident and as per discharge summary (Annexure P-3), he had received injuries in his abdomen and fracture in upper limb. During trial the respondents were declared hostile.

Counsel for respondents No.2 submits that there is a compromise.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stand quashed.

Disposed of.
