The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.306 dated 24.12.2013 registered under Sections 498-A/406 IPC at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

The petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 31.03.2014. The allegations have surfaced in the backdrop of marital dispute. Number of attempts were made to settle the dispute but none has materialized.

It is not in dispute that challan has already been submitted and the petitioner had been granted interim bail. If that be so, the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC stands satisfied. Consequently, the petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 31.03.2014 are hereby made absolute subject to condition that the petitioner would continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Trial Court is expected to decide the matter expeditiously.
