Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.293 dated 15.11.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 354, 427, 452, 148, 149, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Nirmaljit Kaur @ Nimo alleging that the petitioners had constituted an unlawful assembly and assaulted the complainant and her husband

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

In view of said circumstances and following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R.(Criminal) 1052***, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
