ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.(ORAL)

Rupinder Kaur and Vishal Bharti, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 and 5. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 01.04.2015, Annexure P-5 to respondent No. 2.

Perusal of the record shows that the representation submitted by the petitioners does not refer to their address. Petitioners are directed to submit fresh representation to respondent No. 2.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of one month and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
