This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.528 dated 21.11.2009 under Sections 420/406/506 IPC at Police Station Assandh (Karnal).

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that petitioner was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated January 5, 2013. Allegation against the petitioner is that he took an amount of ₹19,50,000/- from three persons on the assurance that they would be sent to Greece. Instead they were sent to Thailand. The incident pertains to the year 2008. Complainants allege that they have been cheated by the petitioner.

In view of nature of allegations, I am of the considered view that the petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
