Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner are major and have performed marriage on 05.04.2015 at Bhramari Devi Jyotish Kender Panchkula. They have threat perception at the hands of private respondents and precisely for that grievance a representation dated 06.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) is statedly pending before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

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Let notice of motion be issued to respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

A copy of the petition be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of nature of allegations and claim put forth by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the allegations made by the petitioners and take appropriate action if required, in the context of providing necessary protection, in accordance with law.
