Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.171 dated 14.7.2014 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was released on bail pending trial. However, petitioner could not appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed as he was unwell. This was the reason that non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner vide order dated 23.1.2015 (Annexure P-4). Thereafter, he moved bail application which was dismissed. He further submits that the next date fixed before the learned trial Court is 16.4.2015. He concluded by submitting that petitioner would be satisfied, if the learned trial Court is directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner sympathetically and also keeping in view the medical record.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court on 16.4.2015 and the learned trial Court shall consider his bail application sympathetically and also keeping in view the medical record of the petitioner, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, instant petition stands disposed of.
