JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 84, dated 22.03.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated February 11, 2015.

2. In compliance of order dated April 29, 2015, parties appeared before Id. Jurisdictional Magistrate for recording their statements. Sheela Devi- mother of complainant-Prem Lata also appeared and got recorded her statement.

3. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that statements given by the parties are not the result of any pressure or coercion and parties have entered into a valid compromise with their free consent and compromise appears to be genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

4. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

5. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 84, dated 22.03.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
