Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 6.3.2015, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court, vide order dated 9.4.2015 has stayed the arrest of the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 9.4.2015 the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh does not dispute the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and further states that their custodial interrogation is not required.

Mr. Brijeshwar Singh Kanwar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant-respondent No.4 and submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have compromised the matter.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 9.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
