MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition for bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. where the petitioner has been implicated in case FIR No.3 dated 3.1.2014 under Sections 420/467/468 IPC registered at Police Station “E” Division, District Amritsar solely on the basis of the fact that he had made telephone calls with one of the main accused, namely, Rakesh Kumar.

Learned counsel for the respondent would contend that through the phone calls the petitioner was asking for delivery of the plot and his complicity stands established. However, he could not give any insight into the basis of such a conclusion as he merely has a telephone calls record and not the transcripts.

Be that as it may, pursuant to the notice motion having

been issued the petitioner has since joined the investigation, which fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from SI Randhir Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid fact when the petitioner has joined the investigation, I would deem it appropriate to accept the instant petition to make the interim directions dated 9.4.2014 absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
